STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Fee for Breweries and Wholesale Outlets to
Sell Malt Liquor.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 28, § 604, amended. The last sentence of the first paragraph of section 604 of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

The fee therefor shall be \$300 per year for each brewery or wholesale outlet owned or controlled by a manufacturer or foreign wholesaler from which malt liquor is transported into this State. Said fee shall accompany the application for certification.
