## STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 104th LEGISLATURE

HOUSE AMENDMENT "E" to S. P. 455, L. D. 1501, Bill, "AN ACT Regulating Snowmobiles."

Amend said Bill in that part designated "§1972" of section 1 (same in L.D.) by striking out all of the 3rd underlined sentence and inserting in place thereof the following underlined sentence:

'The registration fee shall be credited as follows: \$4 of each fee shall be credited to the Department of Inland Fisheries and Game and \$6 of each fee shall be annually distributed to the municipality of the owner's residence as shown on his registration certificate.'

Further amend said Bill in that part designated "§1972" of section 1 (same in L. D.) by striking out all of the 2nd underlined sentence of the 2nd paragraph which reads as follows:

The moneys credited to the State Park and Recreation Commission shall
be expended for the purpose of marking and clearing of snowmobile
trails and providing state-wide maps and trail charts and other educational
and informational materials for the use of operators of snowmobiles."

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of section 8.

Further amend said Bill by renumbering section 9 to be section 8.
