SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to S.P. 455, L.D. 1501, Bill, "AN ACT  
Regulating Snowmobiles."

Amend said Bill in section 1 by striking out all of the first  
paragraph of that part designated "§1972" (same in L.D.) and inserting  
in place thereof the following:

'Except as otherwise provided, no snowmobile shall be operated  
within the jurisdiction of the State unless registered by the owner  
as provided in this chapter. The Commissioner of Inland Fisheries  
and Game is authorized to register and assign a registration number  
to all snowmobiles, upon application and payment of an annual fee of  
\$13 by the owner. The registration fee shall be credited as follows:  
\$3 of each fee shall be credited to the Department of Inland Fisheries  
and Game and \$10 of each fee shall be annually distributed to the  
municipality of the owner's residence as shown on his registration  
certificate. All the moneys received under this chapter, including  
dealer license fees, shall be credited to the Department of Inland  
Fisheries and Game.'
