STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Revising the Laws Relating to Physicians and Surgeons.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 32, § 3152, repealed. Section 3152 of Title 32 of the Revised Statutes is repealed.

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 32, § 3203, amended. The first paragraph of section 3203 of Title 32 of the Revised Statutes, as repealed and replaced by section 4 of chapter 251 of the public laws of 1965, is amended to read as follows:

The board, its members or agents, shall investigate all complaints and all cases of noncompliance with or violations of this chapter relating to the registration and activities of physicians and surgeons and it may file a complaint in accordance with the Administrative Code, Title 5, sections 2301 to 2452, praying for the suspension or revocation of any license or certificate issued under this chapter for any of the following reasons: Conviction in this or another state or in a federal court of a felony or of a crime involving moral turpitude or the suffering of a mental illness of such nature as to interfere with the safe practice of medicine; fraud in the procurement of a license or certificate under this chapter or unprofessional conduct.
