HOUSE AMENDMENT "A " to H. P. 1198, L. D. 1519, Bill, "AN ACT
Permitting Attendance Promotions by Liquor Licensees."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the amending
clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Nothing in this section shall be construed to prohibit a licensed
club from offering prizes, gratuities or other inducements, otherwise
legal, to the general public as a means of promoting attendance on licensed
premises.'
