AN ACT Permitting Attendance Promotions by Liquor Licensees.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 28, § 305, amended. Section 305 of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding at the end, a new paragraph, as follows:

Nothing in this section shall be construed to prohibit a licensed restaurant, class A restaurant, tavern, class A tavern, hotel or club, from offering prizes, gratuities or other inducements, otherwise legal, to the general public as a means of promoting attendance on licensed premises.
