SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to S.P. 470, L.D. 1528, Bill, "AN ACT  
Revising the Law Regulating the Alteration of Wetlands."

Amend said Bill by adding at the end, before the period, of  
the 2nd paragraph of section 2 (same in L.D.) the underlined words  
and comma ', except that coastal wetlands shall not be construed  
to include all that portion of Portland Harbor lying westerly of  
a line running between the most easterly point of Spring and  
Martin Points in said harbor and heretofore exclusively under  
the jurisdiction of the Board of Harbor Commissioners for the  
Harbor of Portland'

Proposed by Senator BERRY of Cumberland.
