CONFERENCE COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to H. P. 1203, L. D. 1530, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to the Military and Naval Children's Home."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the Title and inserting in place thereof the following:

'AN ACT Appropriating Funds for Military and Naval Children's

Further amend said Bill by striking out everything after the.

Title and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Emergency preamble.' Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the said 90-day period will not terminate until after the beginning of the next fiscal year; and

Whereas, certain obligations and expenses incident to the operation of the Military and Naval Children's Home will become due and payable on or immediately after July 1, 1969; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund the sum of \$145,881 to the Department of Mental Health and Corrections

for the operation of the Military and Naval Children's Home. The breakdown shall be as follows:
