HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H. P. 1204, L. D. 1531, Bill, "AN ACT Increasing Certain Fish and Game Fines."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of section 3 (same in L.D.) and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 3. R. S., T. 12, §2455, amended. The last paragraph of section 2455 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

No person shall have in his possession at any time any wild bird or wild animal, or part thereof, taken in violation of this section, except as provided in section 2358. Any person convicted of a violation under this section shall be punished for the first offense by a fine of not less than \$200 <u>\$300</u> and costs nor more than \$400 <u>\$500</u> and costs, which fine and costs shall not be suspended, and-an-additional-penalty-of-not-more-than-30-days-in jail;-at-the-discretion-of-the-court; and for a 2nd or subsequent offense, by a fine of not less than \$400 <u>\$500</u> and costs nor more than \$400 <u>\$1,000</u> and costs, and-30-days-in-jail; which fine; <u>and</u> costs and-jail-sentence shall not be suspended;-and-an-additional-penalty of-not-more-than-60-days-in-jail;-at-the-discretion-of-the-court.'
