## STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 104th LEGISLATURE

HOUSE AMENDMENT "C" to H. P. 1204, L. D. 1531, Bill, "AN ACT Increasing Certain Fish and Game Fines."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of section 3 (same in L.D.) and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 3. R. S., T. 12, § 2455, amended. The last paragraph of section 2455 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

No person shall have in his possession at any time any wild bird or wild animal, or part thereof, taken in violation of this section, except as provided in section 2358. Any person convicted of a violation under this section shall be punished for the first offense by a fine of not less than \$200 \$300 and costs nor more than \$400 \$500 and costs, which fine and costs shall not be suspended, and-an-additional-penalty-of-not-more-than-30-days-in-jail;-at-the-discretion-of-the-court and for a 2nd or subsequent offense, by a fine of not less than \$400 \$500 and costs nor more than \$600-\$1,000 and costs, and 30 days in jail, which fine and costs and jail sentence shall not be suspended, and an additional penalty of not more than 60 days in jail, at the discretion of the court.
