SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 463, L.D. 1537, Resolve,
Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution Regulating the Size
of the State Senate.

Amend said Resolve in the 11th line (9th line in L.D.)
by striking out the underlined word "forty-one" and inserting
in place thereof the underlined word 'thirty-five'

Further amend said Resolve in the "Form of question" by
striking out all of the 2nd paragraph (same in L.D.) and inserting
in place thereof the following:

' "Shall the Constitution be amended as proposed by a resolution
of the Legislature to provide for an odd numbered Senate of not
less than thirty-one nor more than thirty-five Senators following
the constitutionally required reapportionment in 1971?" '
