HOUSE AMENDMENT "A " to H. P. 1210, L. D. 1539, Bill, "AN ACT
Relating to Regional Planning and Establishing Regional Councils of
Governments."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the last underlined
paragraph of section 2 and inserting in place thereof the following
underlined paragraph:

'4. Agreements. The Governor, with the consent of the United
States Congress, may enter into agreements on behalf of the State
with the governor or premier of an adjoining state or province of Canada
to establish interstate or international regional planning or
development districts.'
