AN ACT Creating a Maine Medical School Commission.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. Commission. A Medical School Commission shall be appointed to make a continuing study of the need for and the feasibility of a 4-year medical school with teaching hospital; to gather such other facts as may be deemed pertinent to the creation of this medical school; and to determine the related health schools that should be associated with the medical school.

Sec. 2. Membership. This commission shall consist of a chairman and 8 other members: Two physicians; a representative from the University of Maine faculty; a representative from the University of Maine Board of Trustees; a representative from the State House of Representatives, appointed by the Speaker of the House, and one from the State Senate, appointed by the President of the Senate; and 2 other members not part of the above groups. The members other than the members of the House of Representatives and the State Senator shall be appointed by the Governor.
