SENATE AMENDMENT "C" to S.P. 464, L.D. 1543, Bill, "AN ACT to Correct Errors and Inconsistencies in the Fish and Game Laws."

Amend said Bill by adding at the end the following section:

'Sec. 60. R.S., T.12, §3602, amended. Section 3602 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes is amended by inserting after the first sentence the following new sentence:

The salmon commission, when it determines that the public exigencies require for the above purposes, may take and hold by eminent domain, land, dams and other structures, flowage rights, mill privileges and rights-of-way on the headwaters of the Dennys River at the outlet of Meddybemps Lake in the Town of Meddybemps. It shall use the procedures set forth in section 2151.'
