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**RESOLVE, in Favor of Matinicus Isle Plantation.**

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**Matinicus Isle Plantation; reimbursed. Resolved:** That there is appropriated to Matinicus Isle Plantation from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$6,000 for school and community center building.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

With this Island some 20 miles off the coast of Maine, the cost of building construction is greatly increased due to water transportation of all materials, board and room for carpenters, plus increased rates for isolated work.

Lobster fishing is the only industry on this Island which, in recent years, has resulted in much depleted income.
