AN ACT Relating to Services of Premises Not Licensed Under the Liquor Laws.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., T. 17, § 2003, sub-§ 2, amended. Subsection 2 of section 2003 of Title 17 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:
- 2. Public place defined. "Public place" as used in this section shall mean any hotel, motel, restaurant, common carrier, dance, entertainment, amusement or sport or grounds adjacent thereto and used in conjunction therewith or any highway, street or lane, to which the public is invited or has access.
