HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " to SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1224,  
L. D. 1556, Bill, "AN ACT to Revise the Liquor Laws."

Amend said Amendment by striking out all of that part  
designated "§ 751-A" of section 19 and inserting in place thereof  
the following:

'§ 751-A. Payment for sales in retail stores

For the purpose of receiving payment at the check-out counters  
for the sale of malt liquor or table wine in retail stores, the  
age of such employee receiving the payment shall not be under 18  
years of age for malt liquor and table wine, provided that an  
employee who is 21 years of age or older is present in the retail  
store in a supervisory capacity.'
