SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1232, L.D. 1565, Bill, "AN ACT
Appropriating Funds for Educational Costs for Maine Students in
Private Schools of Higher Education."

Amend said Bill in section 1 by striking out all of the 2nd
underlined sentence of that part designated "\$2323" and inserting in
place thereof the following underlined sentence: 'The fund shall
initially be in the sum of \$200,000.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of section 2 (same
in L.D.) and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General
Fund to the Department of Education the sum of \$208,500 to carry out
the purposes of this Act. The breakdown shall be as follows:
