SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 1232, L.D. 1565, Bill, "AN ACT Appropriating Funds for Educational Costs for Maine Students in Private Schools of Higher Education."

Amend said Bill in that part designated "§2325" of section 1 by striking out in the 3rd line (2nd line in L.D.) the underlined figure and word "12 months" and inserting in place thereof the underlined figure and word '3 years', and by adding at the end of said section the following underlined paragraph:

'No grant shall be given to any student whose total gross income together with that of his parents exceeds \$5,000 for the prior calendar year of both the student and his parents pursuant to the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 of the United States, as amended, in effect on December 31, 1965.'

Further amend said Bill in that part designated "§2326" of section 1 by inserting after the first paragraph the following underlined paragraph:

'If more than one eligible student for which the parent provides a majority of support is registered in an institution and qualifies for a grant under this chapter, the combined effective income of the parent shall be divided by the number of eligible students in the family in determining the amount of the grant payable to each student.'
