HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1236, L. D. 1569, Bill,
"AN ACT to Extend Registration Coverage and to Provide Increased
Fees in Lieu of Personal Property Tax on Certain Watercraft."

Amend said Bill in section 1 by striking out all of that part designated "§ 2493-A" (same in L.D.) and inserting in place thereof the following:

'§ 2493-A. Injuring or tampering with watercraft

Whoever shall willfully break, injure, tamper with or remove any part or parts of any watercraft, or any equipment or property aboard any watercraft, against the will or without the consent of the owner of such watercraft shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$5,000 and by imprisonment for not more than 5 years.

Further amend said Bill in section 10 by striking out all of paragraph A of subsection 1 of that part designated "§ 233" (same in L.D.) and inserting in place thereof the following:

A. Any watercraft whose sole means of propulsion is
manual; any motorboat 18 feet or less in length and
propelled by machinery of 3 horsepower or less; and
watercraft whose means of propulsion is by sail and 12 feet
or less in length.'
