HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 1236, L.D. 1569, Bill, "AN ACT to Extend Registration Coverage and to Provide-Increased Fees in Lieu of Personal Property Tax on Certain Watercraft."

Amend said Bill in section 1 by striking out all of that part designated "§ 2493-A" (same in L.D.) and inserting in place thereof the following:

'§ 2493-A. Injuring or tampering with watercraft

Whoever shall willfully break, injure, tamper with or remove any part or parts of any watercraft, or any equipment or property aboard any watercraft, against the will or without the consent of the owner of such watercraft shall be punished by a fine of not less that than \$100 nor more than \$5,000 and by imprisonment for not more than 11 months for the first offense and for not more than 5 years for subsequent offences, or by both.

Further amend said Bill in section 2 by striking out all of that part designated paragraph "L" and inserting in place thereof the following:

'L. All undocumented watercraft for which a valid certificate of number has been issued and all documented watercraft for which the annual fee has been paid and an official fee receipt issued, under Title 38, sections 233 and 234.
