SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1241, L.D. 1976, BILL, "AN ACT to Incorporate the Town of Flagstaff."

Amend said Bill in section 5 by striking out in the last 7 lines of the first paragraph (last 6 lines of L.D.) the following:

"and said election may be held although the number of persons shown by returns of the State Tax Assessor in said part of Township 3, Range 3 BKP WKR which lies southerly or easterly of the thread of the Lead River, as said thread existed prior to the erection of a dam on said river at Long Falls, so called, and the North One-Half so called of Township 4, Range 3, BKP WKR located in Somerset County, is less than 20'
