SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1244, L.D. 1579, Bill, "AN ACT to Make Allocations from the General Highway Fund for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1970 and June 30, 1971."

Amend said Bill in section 1 under the caption "HIGHWAYS AND BRIDGES" by striking out the lines:

"Highway Construction - State - Federal	8,798,878	8,219,053
Debt Retirement	3,505,000	3,906,000
Interest on Bonded Debt	1,680,075	2,014,025"

and inserting in place thereof the lines:

'Highway Construction - State - Federal	4,518,931	2,999,000
Debt Retirement	3,505,000	4,306,000
Interest on Bonded Debt	1,880,075	2,214,025'

Further amend said Bill in section 1 by striking out all of the last 3 lines and inserting in place thereof the following lines:

'Total Allocations	\$46,570,277	\$48,948,918
--------------------	--------------	--------------

Amounting to \$46,570,277 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1970 and \$48,948,918 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1971.'
