HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 1247, L. D. 1582, Bill, "AN ACT  
Relating to Credit Reports."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of that part designated  
"§1402" and inserting in place thereof the following:

'§1402. Mercantile agencies; qualified privilege

In any civil action for defamation or negligent misstatement,  
any individual, partnership, company or corporation, which, for  
remuneration, furnishes to anyone information concerning the credit  
standing, finances, background, morals or any personal data of any  
individual, partnership, company or corporation shall not be entitled  
to assert the defense of qualified or conditional privilege.'
