SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1248, L.D. 1583, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Civil Service Commission in City of Auburn."

Amend said Bill by inserting before the Referendum the following underlined paragraph:

'The examination is designed to test the physical, moral and mental qualifications of candidates, including an inquiry into their strength, activity, power or endurance, courage, self-control, judgment, willingness to obey, disposition, quickness of comprehension, manners, bearing, accuracy of perception, thought and expression, promptness, leadership qualities, capacity and willingness to learn. The results of each examination shall be filed with the city clerk not later than 30 days after the date of the examination.'
