#### STATE OF MAINE

## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Increasing the Salaries of Justices and Judges of the Supreme, Superior and District Courts.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 4, § 4, amended. The first sentence of section 4 of Title 4 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 5 of chapter 412 of the public laws of 1965 and by section 3 of chapter 476 of the public laws of 1967, is further amended to read as follows:

The Justices of the Supreme Judicial Court shall each receive an annual salary of \$20,000 \$22,000, and the Chief Justice of the Supreme Judicial Court shall receive an annual salary of \$21,500 \$23,500.

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 4, § 102, amended. The first sentence of section 102 of Title 4 of the Revised Statutes, as repealed and replaced by section 3 of chapter 513 of the public laws of 1965 and as amended by section 4 of chapter 476 of the public laws of 1967, is further amended to read as follows:

Each of the Justices of the Superior Court shall receive an annual salary of \$19,500 \$22,000.

Sec. 3. R. S., T. 4, § 157, amended. The 4th sentence of section 157 of Title 4 of the Revised Statutes, as repealed and replaced by section 5 of chapter 513 of the public laws of 1965 and amended by section 6 of chapter 476 of the public laws of 1967, is further amended to read as follows:

Each judge shall receive an annual salary of \$15,000 \$17,000 and the Chief Judge shall receive an annual salary of \$16,000 \$18,000.

Sec. 4. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund the sum of \$79,265 to carry out the purposes of this Act. The breakdown shall be as follows:
