SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1253, L.D. 1589, Bill, "AN ACT to Allow the Chief Liquor Inspector to Continue in his Position Beyond the Mandatory Retirement Age."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the Title and inserting in place thereof the following:

'AN ACT Relating to the Term of Office of the Chief Inspector of the State Liquor Commission.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Term of Office of Chief Inspector. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, Timothy J. Murphy, Chief Inspector of the State Liquor Commission, shall be permitted to continue in his position as Chief Inspector until his 70th birthday subject to removal, however, by a majority vote of the Governor and the individual members of the Executive Council acting as one body.'
