## STATE OF MAINE SENATE 104th LEGISLATURE

SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1263, L.D. 1593, Bill, "AN ACT Creating a Human Rights Act for Maine."

Amend said Bill in that part designated "§4554" by striking out the period at the end of subsection 7 and inserting in place thereof the following: ',excepting all law enforcement agencies and courts of this State and the United States.'

Further amend said Bill in that part designated "<u>\$4566</u>" by inserting in the 7th line (same in L.D.) after the word "<u>persons</u>" the following: '<u>,excepting law enforcement agencies and courts of</u> this State and the United States'

Further amend said Bill in subsection 4 of that part designated "\$4566" by inserting in the 6th line (same in L.D.) after the words "and hearings" the following: ',except that there shall be executive privilege for law enforcement agencies and courts of this State and the United States'
