SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1263, L.D. 1593, Bill, "AN ACT
Creating a Human Rights Act for Maine."

Amend said Bill in that part designated "§4554" by striking
out the period at the end of subsection 7 and inserting in place
thereof the following: ',excepting all law enforcement agencies
and courts of this State and the United States.'

Further amend said Bill in that part designated "§4566" by
inserting in the 7th line (same in L.D.) after the word "persons"
the following: ',excepting law enforcement agencies and courts of
this State and the United States'

Further amend said Bill in subsection 4 of that part designated
"§4566" by inserting in the 6th line (same in L.D.) after the words
"and hearings" the following: ',except that there shall be executive
privilege for law enforcement agencies and courts of this State and
the United States'
