SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1270, L.D. 1598, Bill, "AN ACT Providing for the Conservation and Rehabilitation of Land Affected in Connection with Mining."

Amend said Amendment by striking out all of the last 5 underlined lines and inserting in place thereof the following:

'An operator shall not be required to provide, in a mining plan, for the reclamation of land affected by mining operations prior to the effective date of this chapter, but shall be required to provide for the reclamation of land affected by a mining operation subsequent to the effective date of this chapter.'
