HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 1270, L. D. 1598, BILL, "AN ACT Providing for the Conservation and Rehabilitation of Land Affected in Connection with Mining."

Amend said Bill in subsection 1 of that part designated

"§ 2202" by striking out in the 2nd and 3rd lines (2nd line in

L.D.) the underlined words "or has been removed" and by inserting

after the underlined words "lands" in the 5th line (4th line in L.D.)

the underlined words "to be"

Further amend said Bill in subsection 1 of that part designated "5 2205" by inserting after the underlined word "land" in the 3rd line (same in L.D.) the underlined words "to be" and by inserting at the end of subsection 1 the following underlined sentence:

'An operator shall not be required to include in the area so designated any areas of land affected by mining operations prior to the effective date specified in subsection 6 nor shall this subsection or subsection 4 apply to any mining operations conducted upon such prior affected areas of land.'
