HOUSE AMENDMENT " D " to H. P. 1270, L. D. 1598, Bill,
"AN ACT Providing for the Conservation and Rehabilitation of
Land Affected in Connection With Mining."

Amend said Bill in that part designated "§2205" by
inserting after subsection 6, the following subsection (same in
L.D.)

'7. Exemptions. Mining for felspar, beryllium, mica
quartz and gems shall be exempt from this chapter.'

Further amend said Bill in that part designated "§2205"
by striking out all of the last underlined paragraph.
