STATE OF MAINE SENATE 104TH LEGISLATURE

SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1275, L.D. 1603, Bill, "AN ACT Providing for Regional Referendum on Location of Industry Substantially Affecting Regional Environment."

Amend said Bill in that part designated "§4961" by striking out in the 9th line (8th line in L.D.) the underlined figure "15" and inserting in place thereof the underlined figure '5'

Further amend said Bill in that part designated "§4966" by striking out in the 10th line (9th line in L.D.) the underlined word "may" and inserting in place thereof the underlined word 'shall'

Further amend said Bill in that part designated "§4968" by striking out all of the first line (same in L.D.) and inserting in place thereof the following:

'\$4968. Hearing an application for determination'

Further amend said Bill in that part designated "§4969" by striking out in the 9th line (5th line in L.D.) the underlined figure "15" and inserting in place thereof the underlined figure '5'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of that part designated "§4970-C" (same in L.D.) and inserting in place thereof the following: '§ 4970-C. Existing industry

This subchapter shall not apply to any industry, plant or operation which is presently constructed and in operation, nor to any industry, plant or operation not presently in operation but under construction providing it has received all municipal, state and federal governmental permission required for completion of construction. This subchapter shall not apply to expansion of or addition to an existing industry, plant or operation provided that such industry, plant or operation is presently operating in the same municipality.'
