SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 1275, L.D. 1603, Bill, "AN ACT Providing for Regional Referendum on Location of Industry Substantially Affecting Regional Environment."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the Emergency preamble.

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of the first line after the enacting clause the underlined abbreviation and figure 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of that part designated "§ 4961" and inserting in place thereof the following:  
'§ 4961. Industry substantially affecting regional environment

An industry substantially affecting regional environment is any industry, plant or operation which by reason of its manufacturing process, or its use or handling of raw materials or products, may tend to harm or endanger or adversely affect to a significant degree the natural environment of a substantial portion of the municipality in which it is to be located, or substantial portions of municipalities contiguous to the municipality in which it is to be located, if so found by the Water and Air Environmental Improvement Commission.'

Further amend said Bill in that part designated "§ 4966" by striking out in the 10th line (9th line in L.D.) the word "may" and inserting in place thereof the underlined word 'shall'

Further amend said Bill in that part designated "§ 4968" by striking out in the first line (same in L.D.) the underlined words "declaratory judgment" and inserting in place thereof the underlined word 'determination'

Further amend said Bill in that part designated "§ 4969" by striking out in the 8th and 9th lines (7th and 8th lines in L.D.) the words "municipalities adjacent or abutting thereto or within 15 miles of the actual location of such industry" and inserting in place thereof the underlined words 'municipalities contiguous thereto'

Further amend said Bill in that part designated "4970-C" by inserting in the 5th line (4th line in L.D.) after the underlined word "construction" the underlined words 'or consideration'

Further amend said Bill by striking out the Emergency clause at the end and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 2. Effective date. This Act shall take effect June 30, 1970.'
