HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P 521, L. D. 1607, Bill, "AN ACT to Authorize the Issuance of Bonds in the Amount of Twenty-one Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars on Behalf of the State of Maine to Build State Highways."

Amend said Bill, in the Title, by striking out the words
"Twenty-one Million Five Hundred Thousand" and inserting in place
thereof the words 'Fifteen Million'

Further amend said Bill by striking out in the 6th line (same in L. D.) the figure "\$21,500,000" and inserting in place thereof the figure '\$15,000,000'; and by striking out in the 11th line (same in L. D.) the figure "\$21,500,000" and inserting in place thereof the figure '\$15,000,000'

Further amend said Bill by striking out in section 2 all of the 8th and the 9th lines(8th line of L. D.) and inserting in place thereof the following:

'State Highways and Federal Aid Systems

\$6,000,000 \$9,000,000'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of the 2nd paragraph of the "Referendum" and inserting in place thereof the following:

""Shall a bond issue be ratified for the purposes set forth in

'An Act to authorize the Issuance of Bonds in the Amount of Fifteen

Million Dollars on Behalf of the State of Maine to Build State Highways',

passed by the 104th Legislature?"'
