# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND SEVENTY

AN ACT Exempting Doctors, Psychologists and Certain Classes of Social Workers from the State Personnel System.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 5, § 634, amended. The 2nd paragraph of section 634 of Title 5 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter 382 of the public laws of 1965, is further amended by inserting after the 2nd sentence the following new sentences:

The salary of a physician, psychologist or psychiatric social worker, employed by the Department of Mental Health and Corrections, shall be determined by the appointing authority and shall not be limited by the maximum salary fixed in the compensation plan, nor shall it be subject to provisions applicable to other professional classifications. In determining the salary for such positions, the appointing authority shall take into account prevailing salaries and fees for similar positions in other public jurisdictions and in private agencies. All other provisions of the State Personnel Law and the rules and regulations shall apply to said employees.
