SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 1309, L.D. 1623, Bill,
"AN ACT TO Clarify the Education Laws and Subsidy Payments."

Amend said Bill by inserting after the enacting clause
(same in L.D.) the following:

'Sec. 1. R. S., T. 20, § 222, amended. Section 222 of
Title 20 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended
by adding after the 6th paragraph, a new paragraph, as follows:

The State Board of Education is authorized to initiate,
negotiate and prepare agreements to add a town or towns to
School Administrative Districts; it may also initiate, negotiate
and prepare agreements to combine 2 or more existing districts.
If such an action is taken, the board shall direct that the towns
and districts involved vote on the agreements in accordance with
this section.'

Further amend said Bill by renumbering sections 1 to 16
to be sections 2 to 17.
