SENATE AMENDMENT "C" to H.P. 1309, L.D. 1623, Bill, "AN ACT to Clarify the Education Laws and Subsidy Payments."

Amend said Bill by inserting after section 14 the following section:

'Sec. 14-A. R. S., T. 20, §213, amended. Section 213 of Title 20 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter 77 of the public laws of 1965, is further amended by adding at the end the following paragraph:

The board may approve the formation of a School Administrative District when 2 or more municipalities located on the same island make proper application even though the total number of resident pupils is less than 100. The application shall state the educational economic and geographic reasons for the formation of the proposed School Administrative District.'
