SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 555,
L.D. 1630, Bill, "AN ACT to Implement the Powers of Municipal
Home Rule."

Amend said Amendment by striking out all of the last 6
lines.

Further amend said Amendment by adding at the end, the
following:

"Further amend said Bill in that part designated "§ 1915"
by striking out all of the first line of subsection 4 (same in
L.D.) and inserting in place thereof the following:

'4. Effective date. If a majority of the ballots cast on
any question under subsection 1 favor acceptance, the new charter,
charter revision or charter amendment becomes effective as
provided below, provided the total number of votes cast for and
against the question equals or exceeds 20% of the total votes
cast in the municipality at the next previous gubernatorial
election.' "
