COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 555, L.D. 1630, Bill
"AN ACT to Implement the Powers of Municipal Home Rule."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of subsection 6 of that part designated "§ 1913" (same in L.D.) and inserting in place thereof the following:

'6. Election. Upon the filing of the final report, the municipal officers shall order the proposed new charter or charter revision to be submitted to the voters at the next regular or special municipal election held at least 30 days after the filing of the final report.'

Further amend said Bill in paragraph C of subsection 4 of that part designated "§ 1914" by striking out in the 2nd line (same in L.D.) the underlined words "new charter or charter revision" and inserting in place thereof the underlined word 'amendment'

Further amend said Bill in subsection 1 of that part designated "§ 1915" by striking out in the 4th line (same in L.D.) the underlined words "and summarized below"

Further amend said Bill in that part designated "§ 1916" by striking out in the next to the last line (same in L.D.) the underlined words "State Law" and inserting in place thereof the underlined words 'Law Section of the Maine State'

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end (same in L.D.) the following underlined section:

'§ 1921. Legislative right

This Act shall not be exclusive and the Legislature shall have the right to grant, amend or revise the charter of any municipality.'
