STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND SEVENTY

AN ACT to Appropriate Moneys for Necessary Non-recurring Items for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1970 and June 30, 1971.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment; and

Whereas, the items included in this Act are urgently needed; and

Whereas, in order to accomplish the greatest possible improvement in the indicated programs to meet the total needs of the people of the State of Maine, it is vitally necessary that they be provided as soon as possible; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Appropriations for the necessary expenditures of State Government. In order to provide for the necessary expenditures of State Government for the next 2 fiscal years, ending June 30, 1970 and June 30, 1971, the following sums or as much thereof as shall be found necessary, as designated in the following tabulation, are hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the General Fund Unappropriated Surplus not otherwise appropriated. Upon receipt of allotments duly approved by the Governor and Council based upon work programs submitted to the State Budget Officer, the State Controller shall

authorize expenditures of these appropriations and revenues accruing thereto, on the basis of such allotments and not otherwise.

Any unencumbered balances remaining at June 30, 1971 shall lapse.
