COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 565, L.D. 1640, Bill, "AN ACT Repealing Provision for StudentTuition in Coordination of Public Higher Education."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the Title and juserting in place thereof the following: 'An Act Relating to Student Tuition in Coordination of Public Higher Education.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following (same in L.D.):

'P. & S. L., 1865, c. 532, §4-E, repealed and replaced.

Section 4-E of chapter 532 of the private and special laws of 1865, as enacted by section 3 of chapter 229 of the private and special laws of 1967, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

Sec. 4-E. Student tuition. The 1968-1969 proportionate difference in student tuition between the then existing University of Maine and the state colleges shall be maintained through the academic year 1971-1972 for those Maine resident students who were enrolled in the university system as of September 30, 1968.
