STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
AND SEVENTY

AN ACT Appropriating Funds for Eastern Maine
Vocational-Technical Institute.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Authorization; appropriation. The State Board of Education is authorized to establish a position and employ a business manager at Eastern Maine Vocational-Technical Institute in accordance with the Personnel Laws.

There is appropriated to the Department of Education from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$11,726 to carry out the purposes of this Act. The breakdown shall be as follows:

STATEMENT OF FACTS
