**AN ACT Appropriating Funds for Grants by the
Maine School Building Authority.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Appropriation. There is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$25,000 for the purpose of making grants to administrative units where the borrowing capacity of the unit, the lease rental policies of the authority, and any other available funds are not sufficient in total to finance minimum school facilities. The breakdown shall be as follows:

STATEMENT OF FACTS

In previous years the Maine School Building Authority has had small sums to make grants to poor school units where local resources and authority aid is insufficient to provide required minimum school facilities. Allocation of any such grants is subject to approval by the Governor and Executive Council.
