SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1317, L.D. 1646, Bill,
"AN ACT Imposing a Tax on the Unorganized Territory Within the
Maine Forestry District for Spruce Budworm Control.

Amend said Bill in the 4th line after the enacting clause
(same in L.D.) by striking out the underlined words "one mill"
and inserting in place thereof the underlined figures and word
'1 1/2 mills'; and by striking out in the 5th line (same in L.D.)
the underlined words "the property" and inserting in place
thereof the underlined words 'forest land'
