SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1323, L.D. 1652, Bill,  
"AN ACT Transferring Funds for Educational Subsidy."

Amend said bill by striking out everything after the  
enacting clause and insert in place thereof the following:

'Educational Subsidy: appropriated funds transferred.'

That part of the appropriations from the General Fund for  
the fiscal year ending June 30, 1970 for the Department of  
Education as enacted by the private and special laws of 1969,  
chapter 121, is adjusted as follows:

EDUCATION, DEPARTMENT OF	<u>1969-70</u>
General Purpose Subsidies to Cities and Towns	
All Other	(216,659)
Industrial Education Subsidies	
All Other	25,000*
Vocational Education - Subsidies	
All Other	56,500*
Subsidies-Regional Technical and Vocational Centers	
All Other	135,159*

\*Any unexpended balance of Industrial Education Subsidies,  
Vocational Education Subsidies, and Regional Technical and  
Vocational Center Subsidies appropriations shall not lapse  
at the end of the 1969-1970 fiscal year but shall be carried  
forward to the 1970-1971 fiscal year to be expended for the  
same purposes.'
