**AN ACT Relating to Use of Town Highway Employees and Equipment on
Certain Highways.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 23, § 706, additional. Title 23 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 706, to read as follows:

§ 706. Town employees and equipment

The selectmen of a town, whenever such selectmen deem it advisable in the best interest of the town, may authorize the use of town highway employees and equipment for the construction of state aid highways, 3rd class highways and Town Road Improvement Fund highways.
