SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1337, L.D. 1666, Bill, "AN ACT  
Relating to jurisdiction of District Court in Divorce Actions."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the last underlined  
paragraph (same in L.D.) and inserting in place thereof the  
following:

'Actions for divorce or annulment may be remanded, upon agreement  
of the parties, from the Superior Court to District Court in  
accordance with rules promulgated by the Supreme Judicial Court.  
An action so remanded shall remain in the District Court, which  
shall have exclusive jurisdiction thereafter.'
