# STATE OF MAINE

## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND SEVENTY

### AN ACT Relating to Jurisdiction of District Court in Divorce Actions.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., T. 4, § 152, amended.** Section 152 of Title 4 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter 236 of the public laws of 1965, is further amended by adding at the end, a new sentence, as follows:

In addition, the District Court shall possess original jurisdiction, concurrent with that of the Superior Court as set forth in Title 19, sections 721 and 752, to alter, amend or suspend decrees of alimony and to alter and amend decrees for the care, custody and support of minor children entered by the Superior Court.
