STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
AND SEVENTY

AN ACT Relating to Code of Military Justice for the State Military Forces.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 25, § 1262, amended. Section 1262 of Title 25 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter 197 of the public laws of 1965, is further amended to read as follows:

§ 1262. Uniform code of military justice applicable

Except as provided in chapters 121 to 139, the National Guard or other authorized state military or naval forces of the State of Maine shall at all times and in all places, and the unorganized militia shall whenever called into service, be governed by the **current** Uniform Code of Military Justice and Manual for Courts-martial, United States, ~~1951, as amended and in effect on January 1, 1965~~ as presently in effect in the national military establishment.
